5.	MFHC Lead Agency Update	<p>2021 Membership Drive – Barbara Wheeler reported that we are still looking for agencies to join, in writing. It provides needed support for our CoC application. Our website has a link to the Membership form.</p> <p>Current Funding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DCF Funding – the CoC needs to ensure we spend down all monies by June 30.</li> <li>• ESG-CV2 will bring an additional \$2,551,910 to the CoC. This must be spent in its entirety by June 30, 2022, although any shelter dollars must be spent by January 31, 2022. There are spend down requirements being built into our contract with DCF for these additional funds. Twenty percent of all ESG-CV must be spent by July 31, 2021, with additional increments to be spent: 40% by Sep 30, 2021, 60% by Nov 30, 2021, 80% by Mar 31, 2022 and 100% by June 30, 2022. The number of persons to be served on a monthly basis is: 34 – Street Outreach, 34 – Shelter, 2 – Homeless Prevention, 10 – Rapid Rehousing</li> <li>• HUD CoC – HUD may have the 2021 NOFA out in May.</li> </ul> <p>CoC Projects</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• TBRA funding for Families in Transition – Florida Housing Finance project eligible to Public Housing Authorities, working in conjunction with the CoC and School Systems, offers 12 months of housing assistance to those meeting the school’s definition of homeless.
