6.	Gaps in Service & Membership Input	<p>B.E. Thompson invited those in attendance to speak of any needs they've learned off, or what may be going on with their agencies. LSF indicated they lost a SOAR processor who didn't leave a password, and they had someone in danger of losing all the processing time for their application. It is important that each agency has someone designated to maintain passwords for all staff accessed sites. SOAR is Supplemental Security Income/Social Security Disability Insurance (SSI/SSDI), Outreach, Access and Recovery. Staff or volunteers are trained to complete disability applications, including corresponding with doctors and gathering all the necessary paperwork to submit a complete application on behalf of those who are homeless or in need, and they do not charge for their services unlike an attorney.</p> <p>Barbara Wheeler announced that even with all the challenges, Amber Tucker, MFHC's Housing Specialist, has been attending lease signings and we've celebrated each and every one by "ringing the bell". B.E. added that if anyone knows any landlords, please send them to MFHC. It might be possible to get lists of available housing from Public Housing Authorities each month. Shay Razaire announced an Anchor program for 14-24-year old's meeting on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday in Tavares. This program is for youth who are transitioning from the foster system.</p>
